1. The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to amalgamate/change, cancel or postpone any Classes should there be insufficient entries received or prevailing weather conditions and/or time restrictions.
2. The Organising Committee and BSJA Jersey accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
3. Local competitors taking part in the show must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey. Please note that headgear must comply with British Showjumping Rules.(Rule 101.3)
4. All horses and ponies, including visiting ones, must be aged four years or over (foaled in or before 2015) and registered with BSJA Jersey or British Showjumping Guernsey and ridden by members in accordance with the prevailing British Showjumping Rules and BSJA Jersey Local Rules.
5. Visiting riders from outside Jersey must take out temporary membership of BSJA Jersey, valid for this show only, and declare their horse / pony winnings in accordance with their prevailing registration body.
6. All British Showjumping Rules from the prevailing Rule Book as amended and 2019 Local Rules apply. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure eligibility to enter a Class.
7. In accordance with Rule 45.7 Ponies with over 300 points winnings must have a current JMB Height Certificate.
8. Please see schedule regarding the number of Classes that may be entered by horses and ponies on each day
9. **Entries** can be made online www.bsja-jersey.com by **5 AUGUST 2019**. Late entries, which will incur a late entry fee of £5 per class, will be accepted at the Showground, **up until the start of the previous Class**. Refund of entry money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.5.

Dodson & Horrell 85cm National Amateur Championship Qualifier – 1st Round

Entry Qualifications: For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Table: A7, Two Phase or Single Phase. Speed: 325m per minute indoor and outdoor.

Qualifies for: 85cm National Amateur Second Rounds. Qualifying period yearly 1 September - 31 August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 85cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 85cm Second Round competition.

Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 85cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships.

Dodson & Horrell 1.10m National Amateur Championship Qualifier – First Round

Entry Qualifications: For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Table: A7, Single Phase, Two Phase. Speed: 325m per minute indoors and outdoors.

Qualifies for: 1.10m National Amateur Second Rounds. Qualifying period yearly 1 September - 31 August inclusive.: Horses which jump clear in the first, round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.10m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.10m Second Round competition. Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.10m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships.

EQUITOP MYOPLAST SENIOR FOXHUNTER – FIRST ROUND

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

- a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 310.6.
- b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2012, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with Rule 310.6.

Table: A7, Single Phase or Two Phase. Speed: 350m per minute (indoor). 350m per minute (outdoor).

A water tray or water type jump is compulsory with minimum spread 1.20m (4ft), maximum spread 3m (10ft) outdoors 2.75m (9ft indoors) with at least two poles over and a take off element in front must be in all Foxhunter First Round Competitions

Qualifies for: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round Qualifying period 1 June - 31 May inclusive. Those horses that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior Foxhunter First Round competitions in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go into the jump off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification.

Dispensation is given to run a First Round Foxhunter/Grade C. This Class requires only one prize fund but a mandatory 1.20m Open or above must be scheduled. The Foxhunter/1.20m can still be scheduled, however, in the event of 30 starters or more, the competition would be split into two, unless there are four or fewer in the Foxhunter when the class will be run as an Open, but any double clear gained by a Foxhunter horse to count towards qualification for Foxhunter Second Rounds. Horses may compete in one section only. If there is only one Foxhunter horse in the class it must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification.

ERASER CLASS

These competitions will be run as Table A4 with the exception that for the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle will be provided. The alternative obstacle will be not less than 10 cms and not more than 15 cms greater on height and will be known as the "Eraser Fence". Each competitor may then choose to jump one or other of the alternatives which form the last obstacle. Any competitor who has incurred faults prior to the last obstacle and who chooses to jump the "Eraser Fence" and jumps it clear will then have four faults "erased" from his/her total score for his/her round (i.e. a four fault round prior to the last obstacle will then count as a clear, an eight fault round prior to the last obstacle will be reduced to a four fault total). Any error incurred whilst jumping the "Eraser Fence" will be penalised in faults in the same manner as for any normal fence (i.e. a knockdown will incur four faults and will be added to the penalties incurred prior to jumping the "Eraser Fence"). The choice to jump the "Eraser Fence" is entirely at the discretion of the competitor and there will be no signal made to inform the rider whether or not he/she has incurred faults in his/her round prior to the last fence. Placings will be determined on faults and time after any adjustments have been made for successfully jumping the "Eraser Fence".
