## Notes regarding the Show

1. The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to amalgamate/change, cancel or postpone any Classes should there be insufficient entries received or prevailing weather conditions and/or time restrictions.
2. The Organising Committee and BSJA Jersey accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
3. Local competitors taking part in the show must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey or day members (see note 6). Please note that headgear must comply with British Showjumping Rules.(Rule 101.3)
4. All horses and ponies, including visiting ones, must be aged four years or over (foaled in or before 2015) and registered with BSJA Jersey or British Showjumping Guernsey and ridden by members in accordance with the prevailing British Showjumping Rules and BSJA Jersey Local Rules.
5. Visiting riders from outside Jersey must take out temporary membership of BSJA Jersey, valid for this show only, and declare their horse / pony winnings in accordance with their prevailing registration body.
6. This show is open to non-members who must take out a day membership for £10. Non-members are not eligible to enter class 9 or 16.
7. All British Showjumping Rules from the prevailing Rule Book as amended and 2019 Local Rules apply. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure eligibility to enter a Class.
8. In accordance with Rule 45.7 Ponies with over 300 points winnings must have a current JMB Height Certificate.
9. Please see schedule regarding the number of Classes that may be entered by horses and ponies on each day
10. All classes will run under BS CLUB rules which allow 3 refusals before you are eliminated.
11. **Entries** can be made online [www.bsja-jersey.com](http://www.bsja-jersey.com) before **21 JULY 2019**. Late entries, which will incur a late entry fee of £5 per class, will be accepted at the Showground, **up until the start of the previous Class**. Refund of entry money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.5.
12. **Also when making your entries you must fill in your help duty on the Google Docs Sheet, the link to this can be found on the website or on the BSJA Jersey Facebook page or contact Helen Clackett directly to arrange – we will be checking and if not completed your entries may be refused.**

### **TEAM JUMPING**

An opportunity for some fun jumping, make up your own team of 4 which should consist of:

#### **Junior**

1x 128cm

1x JD registered pony 0-150 points

1x Open pony

The 4th member can be from any of the above. So you could have 2 x128cm, 1 JD and 1 Open.

#### **Senior**

1x Novice Horse with 0-150 Points

1x Grade C Horse

1x Open Horse

The 4th member can be from any of the above. So you could have 1x Novice horse, 2 Grade C's and 1 Open

The teams don't all have to be from the same Parish. However, if your team is from the same Parish then you could win the Parish Team Trophy, which will be awarded to the highest placed Parish team of both Juniors and Seniors

Each grade will jump together so in the Junior Team Competition, all the 128cms will jump, then the JD ponies and then the open ponies. The overall score for the team will be the best 3 scores.
